HOUSE BILL ***1611***

AN ACT establishing a committee to study off-shore wind energy development.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Eighteen

AN ACT establishing a committee to study off-shore wind energy development.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study off-shore wind energy
2 development.

3 2 Membership and Compensation.

4 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

5 (a) Five members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
6 of representatives.

7 (b) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

8 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
9 the duties of the committee.

10 3 Duties. The committee shall study off-shore wind energy development. The committee may
11 solicit testimony from any person or organization with information relevant to the committee's
12 objective.

13 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
14 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house
15 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
16 section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

17 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
18 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
19 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before December 1, 2018.

20 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
